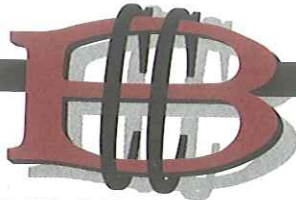
The Service concurs with your determination that the proposed construction may affect, but is not likely to adversely affect the Scaleshell (*Leptodea leptodon*), Gray Bat (*Myotis grisescens*), Indiana Bat (*Myotis sodalis*), Missouri Bladderpod (*Physaria filiformis*), Rabbitsfoot (*Quadrula cylindrica cylindrica*), proposed endangered Northern Long-eared Bat (*Myotis septentrionalis*), or federally protected Bald Eagle (*Haliaeetus leucocephalus*).
